Sunday, October 16, 2011, 10:00 AM - 12:00 PM – GRTTC Fall Tour and Lunch

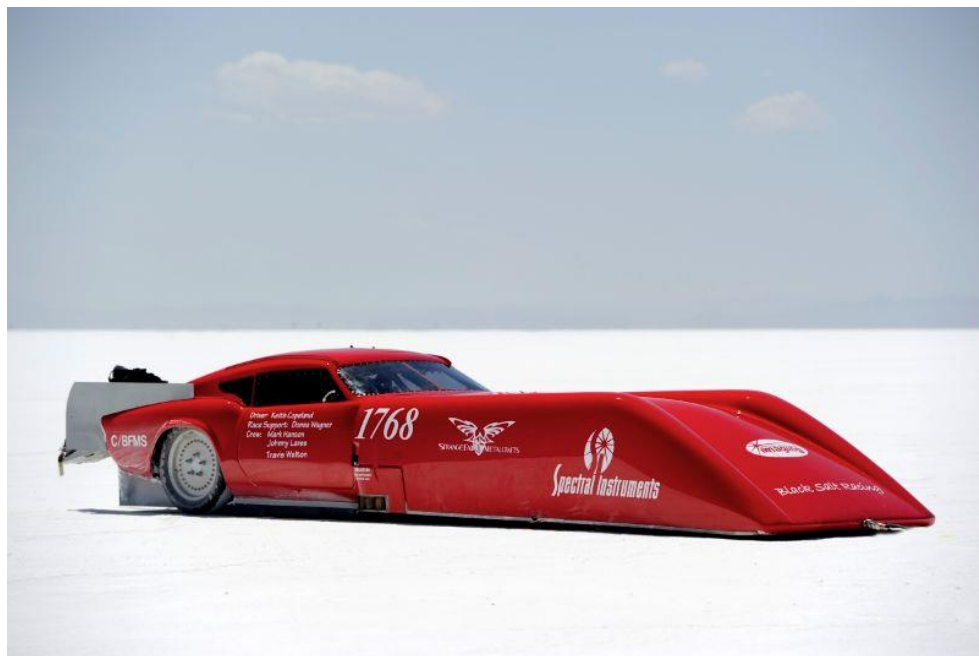
