Wolseley was a British auto maker which was formed by Herbert "Pa" Austin who later went on to form the respected pioneering auto making firm which bore his last name "Austin". Wolseley itself made a number of respected automobiles. Among these were *Wolseley* "Horizontal-Engined Models" which were made and sold in Wolseley single, twin and four cylinder cars built between the years 1900 to 1905.
